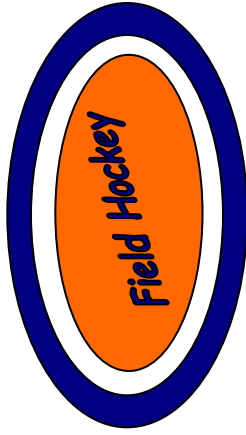

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

What type of player is Mulligan Field Hockey Academy looking for and what are the benefits of playing on a Divots team? We are looking for the player who is willing to give their time and energy to improve both as an individual player and as a team. Players should be able to make the commitment to attend practices leading up to all tournaments.

The athlete who wants to play at the next level has the biggest benefits of playing on a club team. However, all athletes will benefit.

There will be additional opportunity for all players even those not selected to the tournament team to play and train together throughout the year and to again, tryout for local and national tournaments.

Dates? Our club runs from September 2009 through May 2010. During that period we travel to tournaments (indoor & outdoor). We have winter indoor league play and regular weekly elite training included in the cost to join.

What is the cost? All athletes on the Divots select team or any athlete participating in the club activities and leagues will pay \$150.00. to join. Athletes playing on select teams will be responsible for all additional costs associated with tournament play and travel including but not limited to uniform, field and coaches cost.

When and where are trainings? Most trainings will be held at the Marina High School and Huntington Beach Sports Complex. Practice on Saturday mornings. There will be some afternoon or night weekend trainings.

What tournaments will the club enter? Festival held over Thanksgiving in Indio, CA. We will also be entering teams in the U-19, U-16 & U14 age group to the Disney Showcase, Phoenix Cactus

Teams will also be entered into indoor and outdoor tournaments during the winter & in the spring, California Cup (Trials for these other tournaments will be announced).

What age group is the club? Festival Team U-19. However, teams are forming for U-19, U-16, U-14 and U-12. Age as of January 1, 2009 for November hockey festival. Example- you must be 15 or younger on Jan. 1, 2008 in order to be eligible for the Under-16 FESTIVAL Team.

How much do the tournaments cost? Each tournament fee is different. For example the Festival Tournament fee is \$300.00 per player and a 120.00 uniform fee, not including lodging.

NOTE: ALL SELECT TEAM MEMBERS MUST BE USFHA MEMBERS.
